What does that mean? I have found that listeners often have only a vague understanding of what we mean when we say that we are non-commercial and listener supported.

So, here is what it means.

1. We are not allowed to do promotional advertising for any *for-profit* business.
2. We are allowed to do full blown promotional advertising for *not-for-profit* businesses.
3. We are allowed to *acknowledge gifts* from for-profit businesses, giving their name, contact information, and a brief description of the service or product that they offer. Such announcements may not contain comparative or qualitative descriptions, price information, calls to action, or inducements to buy, sell, rent or lease.

Many of our business sponsors give solely to support our ministry. But often they are called on by our listeners *because* our listeners appreciate their support of our ministry.

Non-promotional advertising works!

Not everyone is called to a ministry, but we are all called to minister. We are all called to minister full time. Thank you for allowing God to use you in support of this ministry. With us, you are ministering 24/7. Thank you for serving with us.

Test The Spirits

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. ² By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God, ³ and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. ¹ John 4:1-3

Test the spirits? How? By this you know the Spirit of God. Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God. What does that mean?

This passage is seldom preached because at first glance it doesn't mean what it seems to say. Do you think that if a person can say that "Jesus Christ has come in the flesh" that he is of God. I think not. Most anyone can say the words. Jesus did come in the flesh, but I think this verse is talking about something totally different. Has Jesus come in the flesh of the person speaking? That would be what determines whether the spirit is of God or not.

There are false preachers. Jesus called them "wolves in sheep's clothing," and said that "we would know them by their fruit." Matthew 7:15-16

They are of the world. Therefore they speak as of the world. ¹ John 4:5

These false preachers preach concerning "worldly things." Hear what John said.

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. ¹⁷ And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever. ¹ John 2:15-17

For those who know the scriptures, it's not so difficult today to recognize many of these false preachers as they live in their mansions, ride in their chaffered limousines and their private jets, while bragging about how their faith has procured for them these blessings from God. It was not their faith or God who gave them this stuff. It was deceived individuals who were told that if they would give to these false preachers that they would prosper. The only one to prosper was the false preacher.

This false theology has been a stumbling block to many. Be encouraged to *know the scriptures*.

If anyone teaches otherwise and does not consent to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which accords with godliness, ⁴ he is proud, knowing nothing, but is obsessed with disputes and arguments over words, from which come envy, strife, reviling, evil suspicions, ⁵ useless wranglings of men of corrupt minds and destitute of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain. From such withdraw yourself. ⁶ Now godliness with contentment is great gain. ⁷ For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. ⁸ And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content. ⁹ But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. ¹ Timothy 6:3-10

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. ⁵ They are of the world. Therefore they speak as of the world, and the world hears them. ⁶ We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error. ¹ John 4:5-6
