DO YOU LOVE ME MORE THAN THESE?

John 21:1 After these things Jesus showed Himself again to the disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, and in this way He showed Himself: <sup>2</sup> Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of His disciples were together. <sup>3</sup> Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We are going with you also." They went out and <sup>4</sup>immediately got into the boat, and that night they caught nothing.

What did Peter mean when he said, "I am going fishing?" I think that the Lord may have seen more in Peters thoughts than simply an outing for the day.

But when the morning had now come, Jesus stood on the shore; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. <sup>5</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "*Children, have you any food?*" They answered Him, "No." <sup>6</sup> And He said to them, "*Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.*" So they cast, and now they were not able to draw it in because of the multitude of fish. Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!"

Jesus revealed himself to Peter and the others, had breakfast with them, and now gets to the real reason for the visit.

So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "*Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me more than these?*" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "*Feed My lambs.*"

Jesus ask, "*do you love me more than these.*" Who or what are the *these*. Most have said that *these* refers to the other disciples. I think not. That would have been a question that Peter could not know the answer to. I think it very well may refer to the fish. Peter had been a fisherman. He had been called away from that profession to began to fish for men, and now he was very possibly beginning to think of returning to his old profession. Therefore Jesus ask, "*do you love me more than these.*" These fish.

Jesus used the Greek word *agapas*, translated love, and meaning total commitment or devotion. Peter responded with the Greek word *philo*, translated love, and meaning an abiding friendship.

<sup>16</sup> He said to him again a second time, "*Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?*" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "*Tend My sheep.*"

Again, the same question and the same response.

<sup>17</sup> He said to him the third time, "*Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?*" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "*Do you love Me?*"

This time a different question. This time Jesus uses the Greek word *philo*, translated love and meaning an abiding friendship.

And he said to Him, "Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You."

Jesus said to him, "*Feed My sheep.*"

Peter answered as he had before, saying that he was a good friend of Jesus'.

So what does this mean?

First, don't even think about going back. God has called you to a different life. Peter was having a new encounter with Jesus. We all probably need that occasionally.

Secondly, is Jesus your buddy or your Lord? Do you like Him, or are you His bondservant?

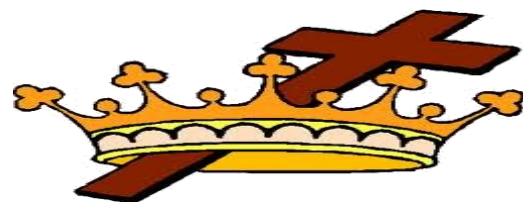
6.) **What is God’s judgement on willful unfaithfulness vs ignorance?** (Luke 12:42-48)
